**Clinic Topic:** Bi-Ski Review - Teach, Tether and ski Levels 1-5

- 1.** Re-visit why we select bi-skis and how they help our guest to get back out on the slopes.
- 2.** Know your guest, find the best bi-ski model for his size, physical abilities and skiing goals and teach them how to use it.

**Strategy/Tactics:** We will discuss different bi-skis available today as well as different outrigger lengths. Lower center of gravity for easier balance . . . On snow we will review a beginning progression, progress to using a chairlift and all the way up to intermediate skills, such as using rotary to adjust turn radius.

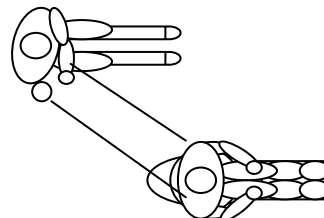
A positive first experience often depends on terrain choice and practicing the appropriate skills. We will discuss and practice different approaches, based on the student's individual needs and goals.

- Bi-unique
- New Bi-unique
- HOC Glide

### Attaching the Tether(s) to the Ski.

- Two points of attachment to ski & tetherer
- Two tethers vs. Single looped tether
- Low on the ski / High on the ski
